



## **Support Measure A1 Implementation! Contact your local representatives!**

EveryOne Home is asking community members to contact their local policymakers to ensure Measure A1 funds are spent.

Measure A1, passed by Alameda County voters in November 2016 is a \$580m housing bond with \$460 million going to a rental housing development fund to support new construction and preservation of existing affordable units targeted to low income residents. It also includes an innovation and opportunity fund that could be used for activities such as land and market rate unit acquisition. Local cities are eligible for a base allocation based on population and property values.

Now in the implementation phase, Alameda County's Housing and Community Development Department (HCD) has released the Base City Funding Notice of Availability (NOFA). Make sure your city takes advantage of this funding opportunity and targets it to help end homelessness! Use the template below when contacting your city. Contact information is on the back.
