#### Oakland

Note: Any families or individuals who are still sheltered but face a crisis such as a 3 day pay or quit notice, an eviction notice, call BACS Keep Oakland Housed Program at **510-613-0330 x2**

#### **Homeless Adults**

- East Oakland: call EOCP Coordinated Entry line at **510-463-4601**, or walk in at 7515 International Blvd. 10am-3pm Thur, Fri

**Homeless families** (with a child under 18)

#### North County (Berkeley, Albany, Emeryville)

#### Mid County

#### East County/Tri-Valley (Livermore, Dublin, Pleasanton)

### South County/Tri-City (Fremont, Newark, Union City)

- Homeless adults: Drop-in hours Mon and Tues 8:30am-12:30pm 4075 Papazian Way, Fremont; call Abode at **510-330-5822**
- Homeless families: Drop-in hours Thurs 10-12 and 1-3pm 39155 Liberty St., Fremont, CA (Millenium Room); call Fremont Family Resource Center at 510-574-2000
  - 4th Thursday of the month from 1-3pm: Ohlone Career Center will provide free, meaningful workforce development, career exploration, and job search/support/placement
  - 1st and 3rd Thursdays of the month from 10am-12pm and 1-3pm: Bay Area Legal Aid will be available for people to talk to an attorney and get information and resources
  - 1st and 3rd Thursdays of the month from 10am-1pm: Bay Area Community Health will be on site to provide non-emergency medical care and social services navigation
  - If an appointment is needed outside of Thursday drop-in hours, appointments can be made on other days. Call 510-574-2000 to seek an appointment.

### Transitional Aged Youth 18-24 years old (Open to all Alameda County Youth - Current Location in Oakland)

Youth are also able to go to adult and family access points.

- Homeless youth: Drop-in hours Tues and Thurs 1-3pm 200 Harrison Street, Oakland and at 16335 E 14th Street, San Leandro Tues and Thurs 10am-12pm; call Covenant House at **510-379-1010** (ask for the Wellness Center)
