The Committee has been working on a project to prepare a Homelessness Prevention Program Chart. A project memo is available here. b. Homelessness Prevention Program Chart to be presented in two ways to two audiences: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Homelessness Prevention Landscape Dashboard: A dashboard focused on the landscape of prevention programs in Alameda County, including how they are funded. The target audience will be system leaders and funders who will use the program information when making decisions about policy, funding, etc. 	1:30-2:20

<p>ii. <u>Homelessness Prevention Resource Guide Dashboard:</u> A dashboard for community members and service providers who will use the program information to identify resources that will help households to prevent homelessness.</p> <p>c. At the last meeting, Committee members reviewed the templates and provided feedback.</p> <p>d. At this meeting, Committee members will review and finalize the dashboards.</p> <p>e. After the Committee members finalize the dashboards, they will be sent to programs to check for accuracy. Programs will be asked to provide any corrections by December 31, 2025.</p> <p>f.
